India VIX was down by ~3.5%. GIFT Nifty is trading down at ~26,416 (-4.00 pts, -0.2%) indicating Indian markets will open positively.

On 27st Nov, advance decline ratio on NSE was 3198: 1476 and BSE was 1936: 2220 which showed positive in the overall markets.



#### **View-Short Term Bullish**

The stock commenced its uptrend from **76** (APR 2025). After few Up Gaps the stock started trading above averages & gradually moved up to **108** (JUN 25). Profit booking followed & the stock made a low of **89** (AUG 25). Later, the stock attracted buying & after crossing 108 (JUN 25) reached a high of **112** (SEP 25).

After correction & forming higher bottoms the stock reached a high of 113, but was unable to sustain. Currently, the stock has given **Cup & Handle Breakout** supported by volumes reaching a high of 116, which is above the previous swing high. The MACD indicator shows **positive momentum**, confirming further upside potential. Target of 162 is expected with lower support levels at (111-109)-105-(101-98) in case of intermediate fall. A stop loss at 92 is to be followed for the trade.


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
