


### Market Review

**US:** Dow Jones futures were little changed overnight, along with S&P 500 futures and NASDAQ futures. The stock market rally was narrowly mixed on Wednesday on the major indexes after pulling back slightly in the prior session.

**Asia:** Most markets in Asia-Pacific region were trading higher on Thursday after US CPI data for October came in line with expectation.

**India:** On Wednesday, the Indian stock market extended decline for the fifth straight session, dragged by weak global cues, a surge in US dollar index and unabated selling by foreign investors. **Market is expected to open on a flattish note and likely to witness range bound move during the day.**

**Global economy:** Australia's job market grew at a slower-than-expected pace in October, as outsized growth in the labour market now appeared to be cooling after six months of strong expansion. The total number of employed people grew by 15,900 in October. The reading was weaker than expectations of 25,200 people, and slowed sharply from the 64,100 seen in the prior month. This brought Australia's participation rate-which gauges the percentage of the population that is in the labour space- down slightly to 67.1% in October, compared to expectations it would remain steady at 67.2%. The unemployment rate was steady at 4.1%.

The latest data on the Federal Budget Balance has been released, revealing that the United States government's income and expenditure balance for the reported month is at a deficit of -257.0 billion dollars. This figure is significantly lower than the forecasted deficit of -226.4 billion dollars, indicating a larger gap between the federal government's income and spending than initially anticipated. The deficit value is also a stark contrast to the previous month's budget surplus of 64.0 billion dollars, thereby marking a substantial shift in the country's fiscal position. The Federal Budget Balance is a crucial economic indicator as it measures the difference in value between the federal government's income and its expenditure during a specific month. A positive number signifies a budget surplus, while a negative number points towards a deficit.

**Commodities:** Oil prices dropped slightly early on Thursday on expectations of higher global production amid forecasts for weak demand growth, while a firmer dollar also kept a lid on prices.

Gold prices were flat on Thursday after hitting a two-month low earlier, pressured by a stronger U.S. dollar and uncertainty regarding the pace of the Federal Reserve's interest rate cuts.

**Currency:** The US dollar reached a one-year high against major currencies, buoyed by Trump's election and expectations for inflation.

**Tata Power Renewable Energy commissions 126 MW floating solar project in MP**

TPREL has commissioned a 126 MW floating solar project in Madhya Pradesh. The EPC project worth Rs 596 cr was awarded by NHDC Ltd to TPREL. TPREL's renewable energy capacity now stands at 10.9 GW with 5.6 GW of projects in various stages of implementation. Its operational capacity has reached 5.3GW, incl 4.3 GW of solar & 1 GW of wind energy projects. (ET)

**Drug maker Cipla gets 8 observations from USFDA for Bengaluru facility**

The US health regulator has issued eight observations in Form 483 after inspecting Cipla's Bengaluru-based plant. The USFDA conducted an inspection at the company's manufacturing facility in Virgonagar, Bengaluru from Nov 7- 13. (BS)

**TATACOMM divests 100% stake in ATM biz for Rs 330 cr**

Tata Communications is set to divest its entire 100% stake to Transaction Solutions International (India), a company majority-owned by Australia's digital payments and financial services provider. The deal, valued at Rs 330 cr, also includes an additional amount linked to interchange rate adjustments outlined in the SPA, potentially amounting to Rs 75 cr. (ET)

Economy

**India's cooking oil imports in 2023-24 are down by 3% as consumption falls due to high prices**

India's year-on-year import of edible oils during the oil year 2023-24 (Oct, Sept) is down by 3% as high prices of cooking oils led to reduction in demand from the lower segments of society. Increase in domestic production of oilseeds also helped in reducing imports. (ET)

**Industrial output expands 3.1% in September on base effect, festivals**

India's industrial output rebounded in Sept'24, growing 3.1%, after contracting 0.1% in Aug'24 - a 22-month low - driven by a favourable base effect and pre-festive season stocking that boosted manufacturing. Excluding Aug'24 performance, the Sept'24 output growth was at a nine-month low. It had increased by 6.4% in Sept'23. (ET)

**CoreWeave closes \$650 mn secondary share sale at \$23 bn valuation**

CoreWeave closed a \$650 mn secondary share sale to investors, a deal that a source familiar with the matter said more than tripled the company's valuation over the past year to \$23 bn. The investors were led by Jane Street, Magnetar, Fidelity Management and Macquarie Capital, and the higher valuation illustrated growing interest in the business of cloud infrastructure for generative AI. 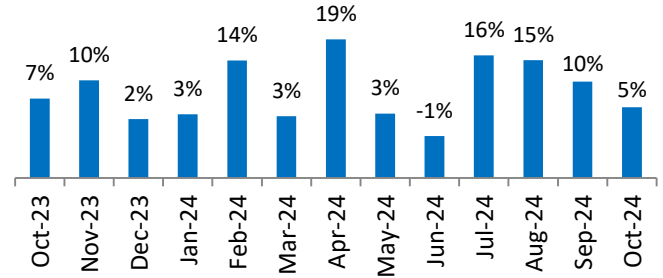
