US: The U.S. stock market fell as Nvidia and other superstars created by the frenzy around artificial-intelligence technology dimmed some more.

Asia: Asian stocks declined at the open after Wall Street's slide, as investors moved away from riskier assets ahead of Nvidia Corp's earnings and a key US jobs report later this week.

India: On Monday, the Indian stock market ended higher, led by healthy across-the-board buying, as upbeat Q2 results, and prospects of an India-US trade deal supported sentiment. Market is expected to open on a negative note and likely to witness range bound move during the day.

Global economy:

Japanese Finance Minister Satsuki Katayama on expressed concern over recent foreign exchange movements, as the yen sank to fresh nine-month lows versus the dollar. As we have recently been seeing one-sided, rapid moves in the foreign exchange market, we have been alarmed, Katayama said at a regular news conference.

Japanese Prime Minister Sanae Takaichi will launch talks this week on a wide-ranging tax overhaul aimed at supporting investment and household spending while seeking new revenue sources to maintain fiscal discipline.

U.S. firms have begun talking more frequently about layoffs as they plan for weaker demand and possible productivity gains from artificial intelligence, Federal Reserve Governor Christopher Waller said in remarks that continued to build the case for further rate cuts amid a broad policy dispute at the U.S. central bank.

Federal Reserve Vice Chair Philip N. Jefferson said that the balance of risks in the U.S economy has shifted, with growing downside risks to employment even as progress on inflation has stalled. Speaking at an event hosted by the Federal Reserve Bank of Kansas City, Jefferson said the economy had been on a moderate growth path before the recent government shutdown.

Commodities: Oil prices dipped on Tuesday as supply concerns eased with the resumption of loadings at a Russian export hub, briefly halted by a Ukrainian drone and missile strike, while traders continued to assess the impact of Western sanctions on Russian flows.

Gold fell for a fourth straight session on Tuesday, weighed down by a firm dollar and diminished prospects of a U.S. interest rate cut next month.

Currency: Asian currencies slipped on Tuesday, extending the previous day's losses with weak risk appetite keeping investors on the defensive. A roughly 1% drop in U.S. equities on Monday boosted demand for the safe-haven dollar.

Corporate News

AstraZeneca partners with Sun Pharma to expand access to hyperkalaemia treatment Lokelmal. Under the agreement, both companies will promote, market, and distribute SZC in India under different brand names—AstraZeneca will market SZC as Lokelma, while Sun Pharma will promote and distribute the therapy as Gimliand. (MC)

TVS Motor launches Apache RTR 180 in Kenya, marking and expansion of its premium motorcycle range in East Africa. It announced the launch on 17 Nov in association with its distribution partner Car & General. (ET)

Nuvoco Vistas has acquired 100% stake of Algebra Endeavour (the holding company of Vadraj Energy, Gujarat), with JSW Cement, Alpha Alternatives Holdings, and Algebra Endeavour, for up to Rs 200 crore. (MC)

WPIL's South African subsidiary has received a contract from METSI KE MATLA JV for complete electromechanical and instrumentation works for the MCWAP2 project of the Trans Caledon Tunnel Authority (SA), valued at 821 Mn Rand (Rs 426 cr). The project is to be commissioned in 48 months. (MC)

Economy

India levied a five-year anti-dumping duty on liquid epoxy resins coming from China, Saudi Arabia, Taiwan and South Korea, aiming to curb low-priced imports that affecting domestic pricing. (ET)

India anticipates gains as the US removes reciprocal tariffs on key agricultural exports. Products like tea, coffee, and spices will now face a level playing field. This move is expected to boost Indian exporters. While some analysts suggest the gains might be modest, the exemptions are seen as a positive development for India's trade. (ET)

India has imposed import restrictions on certain types of platinum jewellery from Apr'26. This follows similar curbs placed on silver jewellery imports in September. The move requires importers to obtain a license from the Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT) for these goods. (ET)

International

Amazon announces \$15 bln US bond offering amid AI spending spree, first U.S. bond offering in three years. The company filed for a six-part issuance with notes dated from 2028 to 2065. Proceeds may be used to repay debts, fund acquisitions, for working capital, and buybacks. (Invst)

BP restores part of Olympic Pipeline after Washington leak. The BP-operated Olympic shut its pipelines in the area after the discharge on Sunday. It consists of two pipelines in the area. The segment of the pipeline system unimpacted by the issue was restored on Sunday, resuming product delivery. (Invst)
