Overnight global action was Negative: On 17th Dec, U.S. markets down with S&P 500 -78.75 pts (-1.16%), Dow Jones down by -228.10 pts (-0.47%) and Nasdaq down by -485.33 pts (-1.93%). India VIX was down by ~2.2%. GIFT Nifty is trading flat at ~25,860 (-12.00 pts, -0.1%) indicating Indian markets will open negatively.

On 17th Dec, advance decline ratio on NSE was 3224: 2083 and BSE was 1403: 2761 which showed balanced in the overall markets.

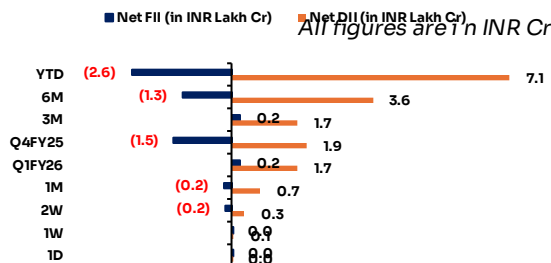

The primary move in the stock commenced from ₹170 (MAY 25). Stock started trading above averages & gradually reached a high of ₹231 (JUL 25). Lower tops were formed, profit booking followed & the stock gave a valid correction making a low of ₹201 (SEP 25). Again the stock commenced its up move & reached a high of ₹220 (AUG 25), but failed to cross the previous high of ₹229 & minor correction followed at 205, forming higher bottoms.

The stock attracted buying interest & started trading above averages reaching a high of ₹258 (NOV 25). Later, the stock entered into a consolidation zone between 258-242 (NOV 25-DEC 25) & recently, gave a **Symmetrical Triangle Breakout** supported by volumes reaching a high of ₹251 (DEC 2025).

The Stochastic RSI indicator suggests **positive crossover**, confirming further upside potential.

The **200 EMA** is in rising mode at 217. Target of **308** is expected with lower support levels at **(244-239)-233-(228-226)** in case of intermediate fall. A stop loss at **219** is to be followed for the trade.
