U.S. Markets Ended Mix with Dow Jones closing at record highs; Oil Prices Hit Three-Month Low

The Dow Jones Industrial Average rose to a record high on Tuesday as investors rotated out of semiconductor names to cyclical stocks, aided by a sharp decline in oil prices.

The 30-stock Dow Jones index advanced 329 points, or 0.64%, for a record close of 51,999.67, after touching an intraday peak of 52,190. The S&P 500 declined 0.57% to finish at 7,511.35, while the Nasdaq Composite slipped 1.15% to 26,376.34.

Pressure on the Nasdaq came from weakness in several chip stocks. Advanced Micro Devices fell more than 7%, Broadcom declined 4%, Micron Technology lost 6%, and Nvidia dropped more than 2%.

Market participants are closely watching the Federal Reserve's policy meeting today, which marks the first chaired by Kevin Warsh. Policymakers are widely expected to leave interest rates unchanged, but markets are assessing whether the central bank's language signals a shift in its policy outlook.

The Bank of Japan raised rates by 25 basis points on Tuesday, saying it will continue tightening policy amid sticky inflation. Alongside the widely expected hike, the BOJ also outlined plans to slow the pace of monthly bond purchases in the coming quarters.

Oil prices fell sharply to a fresh three-month low on growing expectations that the Strait of Hormuz may be fully reopened after representatives from Washington and Tehran meet in Switzerland on Friday to formalize a memorandum of understanding between the two sides. WTI July futures fell nearly 6% to \$76 per barrel, while Brent dropped about 5% to \$79.

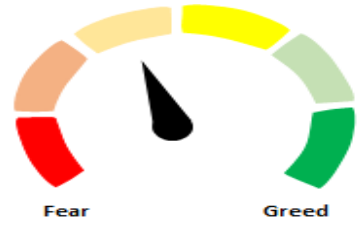
Asian markets are trading mixed today as investors await the U.S. Federal Reserve's rate decision.

Back home, the Nifty extended gains for a third straight session, rising 135 points to close at 23,989, its highest finish since May 25. The rupee also strengthened, appreciating 15 paise to 94.56, supported by a favourable macro backdrop and easing crude prices.

The short-term trend remains positive, with Nifty trading above its key short-term moving averages. On the upside, the 100-day exponential moving average near 24,150 remains the key hurdle. Since the escalation in the Middle East (US-Iran-Israel) began, Nifty has not been able to sustain a move above that level. Two prior attempts in April and May 2026 failed to clear this resistance. A decisive close above 24,150 would establish bullish momentum on positional charts.

On the downside, the 50-day EMA near 23,780 is expected to act as immediate support. As long as the index holds above this level, the short-term outlook remains positive

Indian markets are set to open flat amid mixed Asian market cues.

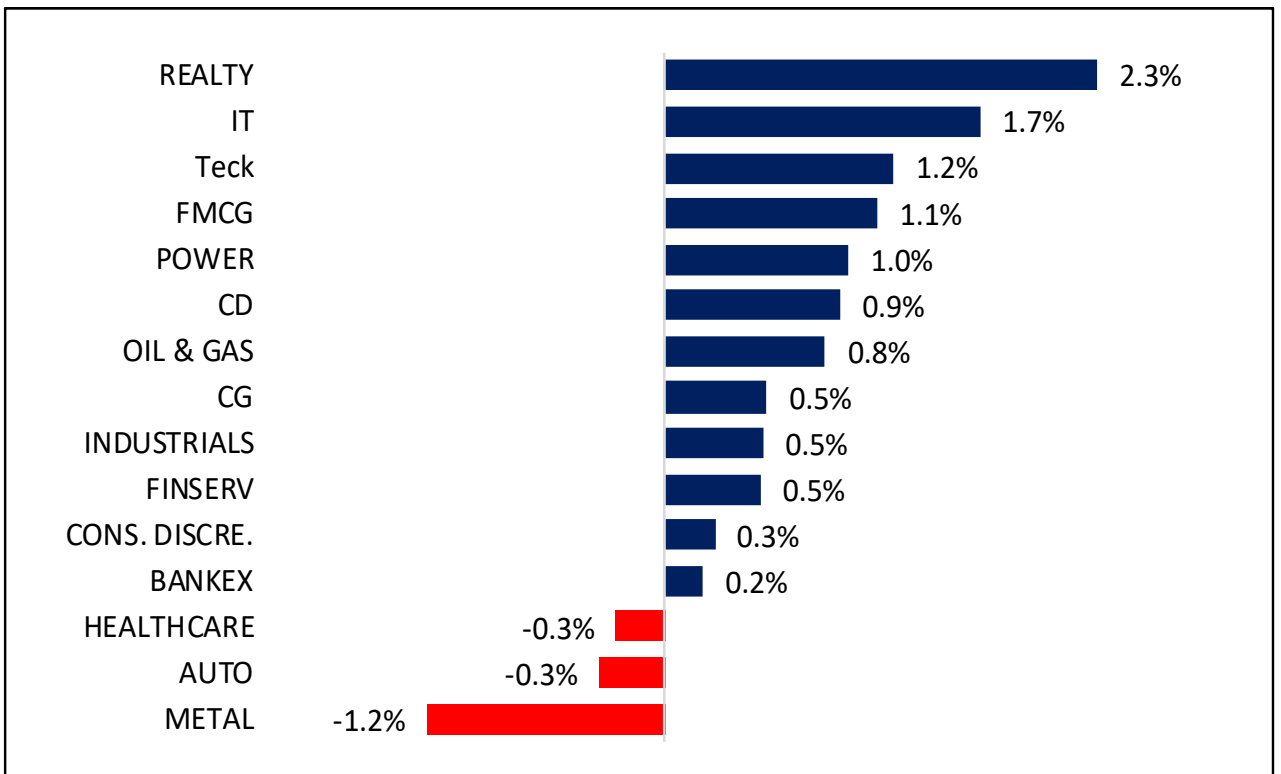

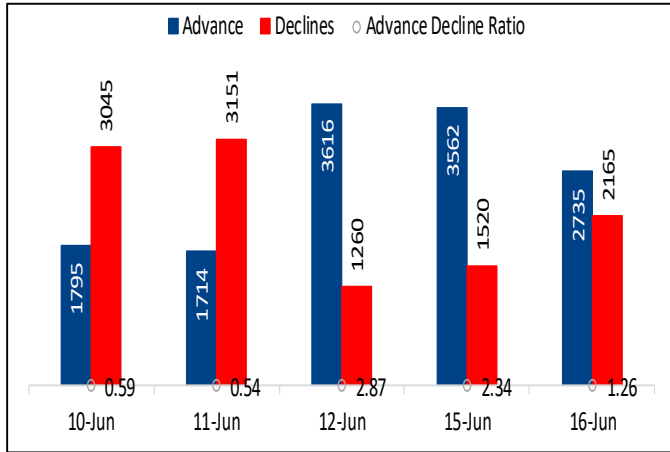

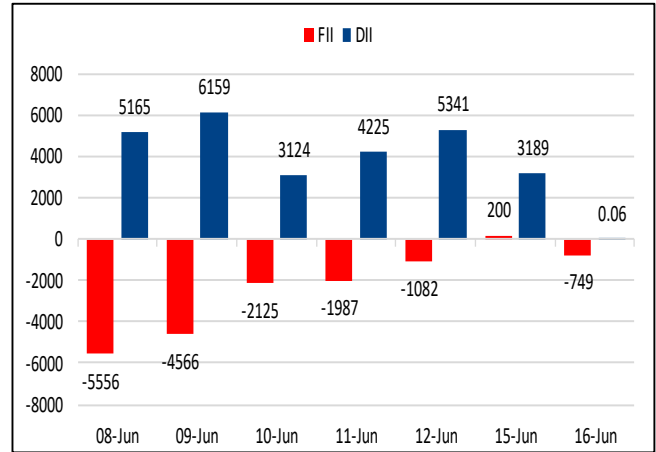

Institutional Activities (Rs Cr)



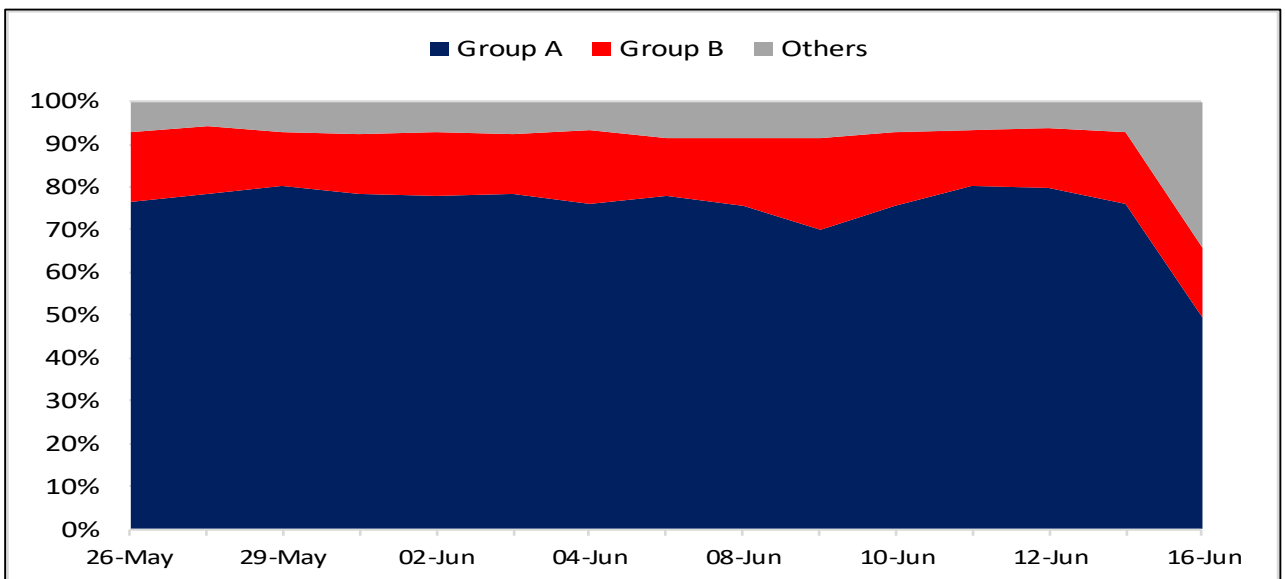

Japan trade balance shrinks less than expected in May as exports surge

Japan's trade balance shrank less than expected in May as the country's exports continued to grow at an accelerated pace on sustained demand in the U.S. and China. Imports also grew sharply in May, albeit at a slightly slower than expected pace, data showed on Wednesday. Japan's trade balance fell to a deficit of 378.7 billion yen (\$2.36 billion) in May, better than expectations for a 564.6 billion deficit. April's trade surplus was also revised lower to 299.3 billion yen.

Building permits decline as economic concerns rise

In a development that has caught the attention of economists and investors, the latest report on building permits reveals a significant downturn. The forecast for building permits had anticipated stability or growth, making the actual figure of -0.7% a surprising and concerning deviation.

German investor morale rebounds on hopes Iran conflict will end

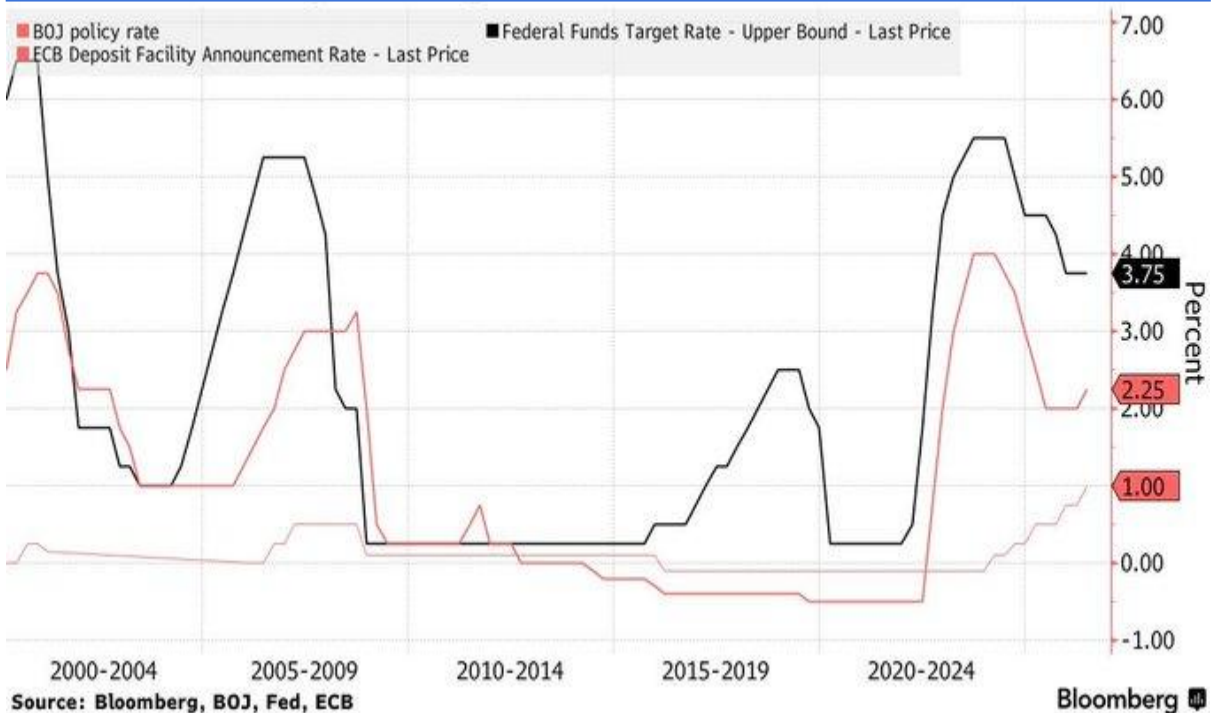
German investor morale rose unexpectedly in June as financial market experts bet the Iran conflict was nearing an end and inflation pressures would ease. The indicator of economic sentiment rose to 10.5 points in June, the ZEW economic research institute said. Analysts polled by Reuters had anticipated the reading to come in at minus 6 points from minus 10.2 points a month earlier.

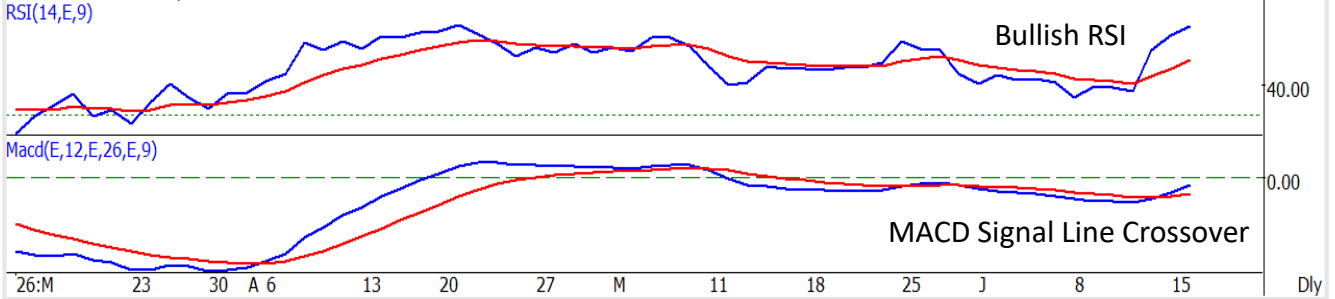
A New Era for Monetary Policy: Navigating Inflation and Global Realignment

- The Bank of Japan (BoJ) raised its benchmark interest rate by 25 basis points to 1.0%—its highest level since 1995—and signalled a shift away from ultra-loose policy by dropping language describing borrowing costs as "significantly low." Concurrently, the central bank announced it will pause its government bond purchase reduction program in April 2027 to keep monthly purchases steady at approximately 2 trillion yen (~\$12.5 billion).
- While this tightening occurs alongside recent rate hikes from the ECB and building speculation of a year-end Fed hike, Japan remains significantly behind the global curve despite its hawkish pivot.

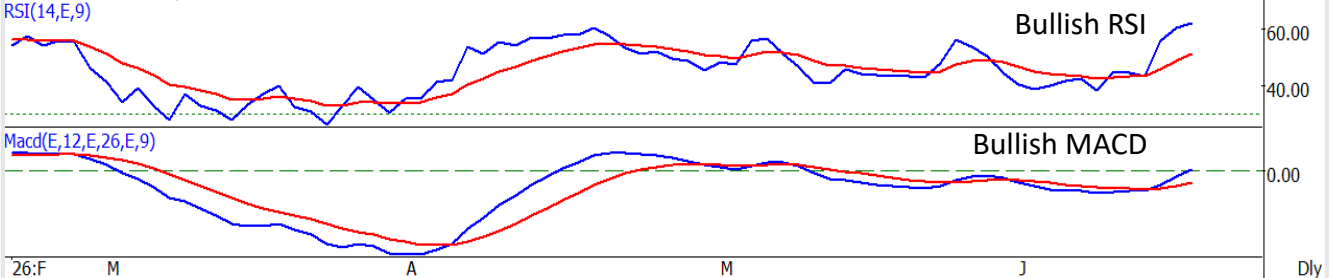
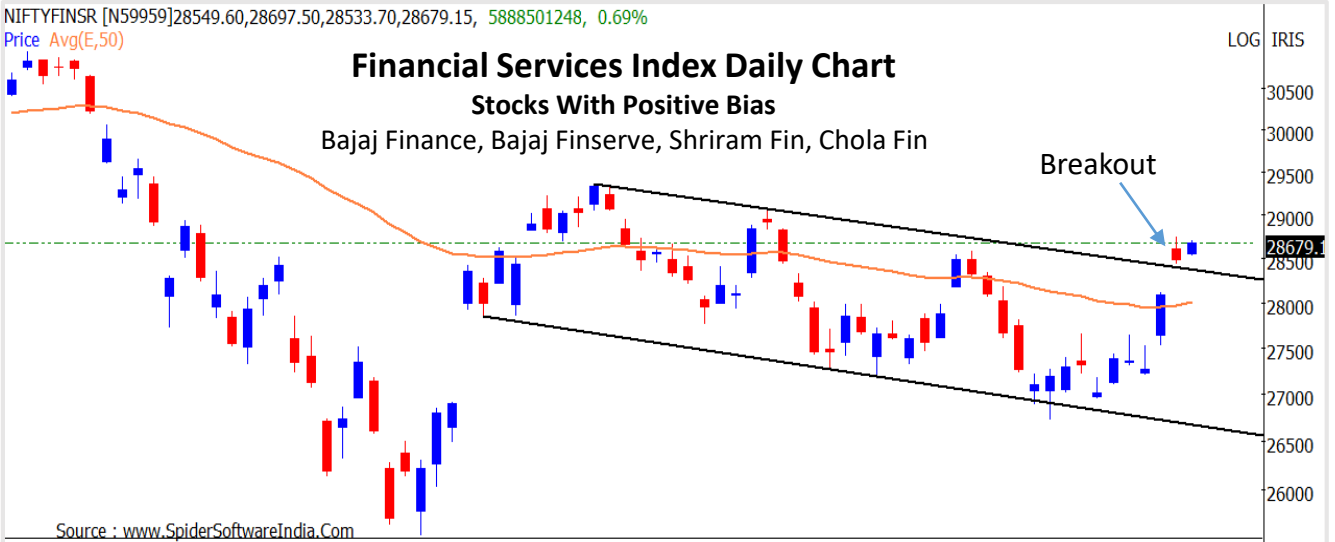
Policy Rate: Europe, Japan and the US

- Nifty extended its rally for a third straight session, gaining 135 points to close at 23,989. Supported by positive global cues and easing crude oil prices, the index traded with a positive bias throughout the day and ended near its session high.
- Short Covering was seen in the Nifty Futures where Open Interest fell by 3.08% with Nifty rising by 0.57%.
- Short Covering was seen in the Bank Nifty Futures where Open Interest fell by 3.10% with Bank Nifty rising by 0.17%.
- Nifty Open Interest Put Call ratio rose to 1.08 levels from 1.04 levels.
- Amongst the Nifty options (23-Jun Expiry), Call writing is seen at 24000-24100 levels, indicating Nifty is likely to find strong resistance in the vicinity of 24000-24100 levels. On the lower side, an immediate support is placed in the vicinity of 23900-23800 levels where we have seen Put writing.
- Short covering was seen by FII's' in the Index Futures segment where they net bought worth 1,783 cr with their Open Interest going down by 15539 contracts.

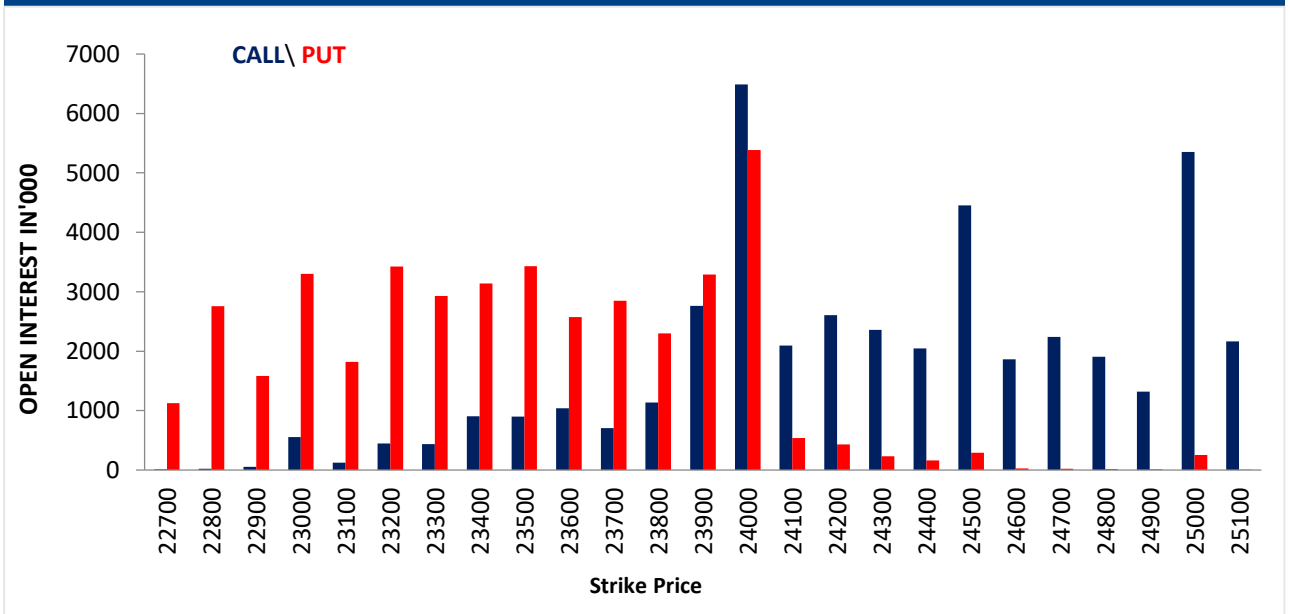
