

Market Commentary

Overnight global action was negative: Yesterday, U.S. markets were negative with S&P 500 down by -44 pts (-0.69%), Dow Jones was down by -249 pts (-0.55%) and Nasdaq was down by -184 pts (-0.79%). India VIX was up by \sim 0.77%. GIFT Nifty is trading negative at \sim 24,626 (-40 pts, -0.16%) indicating Indian markets will open negative.

Yesterday, advance decline ratio on NSE was 1,927: 1,116 and BSE was 2,439: 1,705, which showed strength in the overall markets.

FMCG: Nifty FMCG index was up by +1.12% with Dabur (+4.19%), Tata Consumer (+2.77%) and UBL (+2.44%) contributing positively to the index.

Consumer Durables: Nifty consumer durables index was up by +0.24%, Bata India (+3.81%), Voltas (+1.64%) and CERA (+1.48%) were supporting the index.

Realty: Nifty realty index was up by +0.72% with Anant Raj (+3.45%), Phoenix Ltd (+3.14%) and Godrej Properties Ltd (+1.42%) among the top gainers.

Metal: Nifty metal index was up by +0.85%, top gainers were National Aluminum (+4.89%), NMDC (+4.71%) and Hindustan Copper (+2.07%).

Oil & Gas: IGL (+2.97%), GAIL (+2.03%) and GSPL (+1.74%) lead the Nifty oil and gas index by +0.62%

Auto: Nifty auto was down by -0.29% with TI India (-2.89%), M&M (-2.33%) and Tata Motors (-0.85%) among the laggards.



2. Quadrant (CMP: 465.35, MCap: 1,861, Sector: Railway Technology, Valuation: -94.61xTTM P/E)

Quadrant received a significant order for the supply of the KAVACH System (Train Collision Avoidance System) at East Central Railway, enhancing its role in railway safety and technology. This order strengthens Quadrant's position in the railway infrastructure space.

Adani Power received government approval to begin coal mining at Madhya Pradesh's Dhirauli Mine, with a capacity of 6.5 million tonnes per year. This development bolsters the company's raw material security for its thermal power generation operations.




