Wall Street Set to Rebound Post Memorial Day Holiday - our Markets to Start on a Cautious Note.

U.S. and British stock markets were closed on Monday in honour of Memorial Day.

U.S. stock index futures rose sharply on Monday evening as investors were relieved by President Donald Trump postponing plans to impose steep trade tariffs on the European Union.

Nvidia is set to report its fiscal first-quarter earnings after the Wednesday closing bell, focusing squarely on whether AI demand remained strong.

Given the holiday in the United States and Britain, trading volumes on Monday were thinner than usual in most markets.

Global markets climbed on Monday, and the euro rallied after U.S. President Donald Trump postponed his threat to slap 50% tariffs on European Union goods until July, marking another temporary trade policy reprieve.

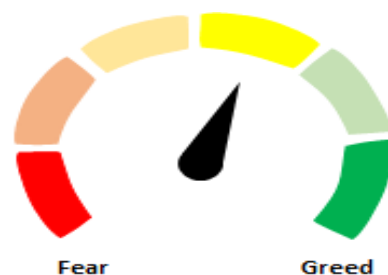
China and Hong Kong stocks closed lower as automobile shares slid on price war concerns, and Apple suppliers dropped on potential U.S. tariffs.

Back home, investor sentiment was boosted by news of US President Donald Trump's delay in additional tariffs on the European Union. Encouraging signs regarding the upcoming monsoon season also contributed to the positive market mood.

The Indian Rupee continued its appreciation for the second consecutive day, rising by 13 paise against the US dollar to settle at 85.08, its highest close since May 7th, 2025.

Technically, the Nifty appears to have regained its momentum, decisively breaking out from its consolidation zone of 24,500-25,000. Immediate resistance is now seen at 25,207, derived from the 76.4% Fibonacci retracement of the entire fall from 26,277 to 21,743. On the downside, 24,800 could offer immediate support for the Nifty.

Our markets are poised to start cautiously on the back of weak Asian cues.

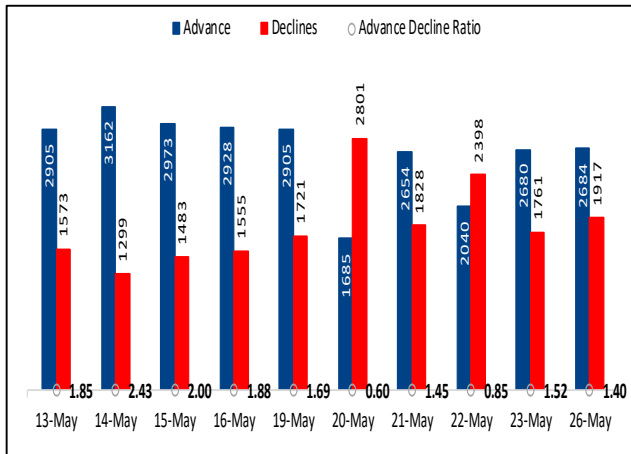

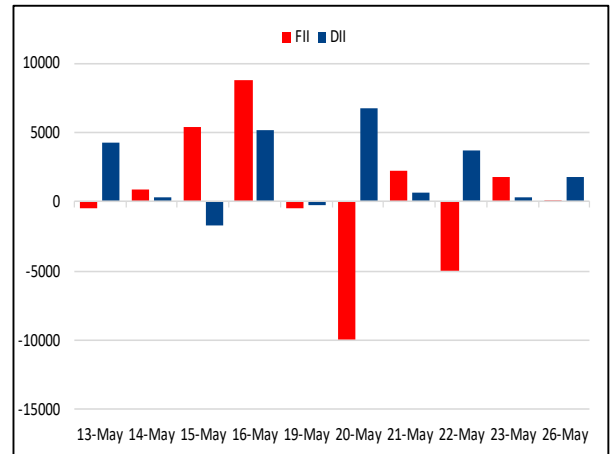

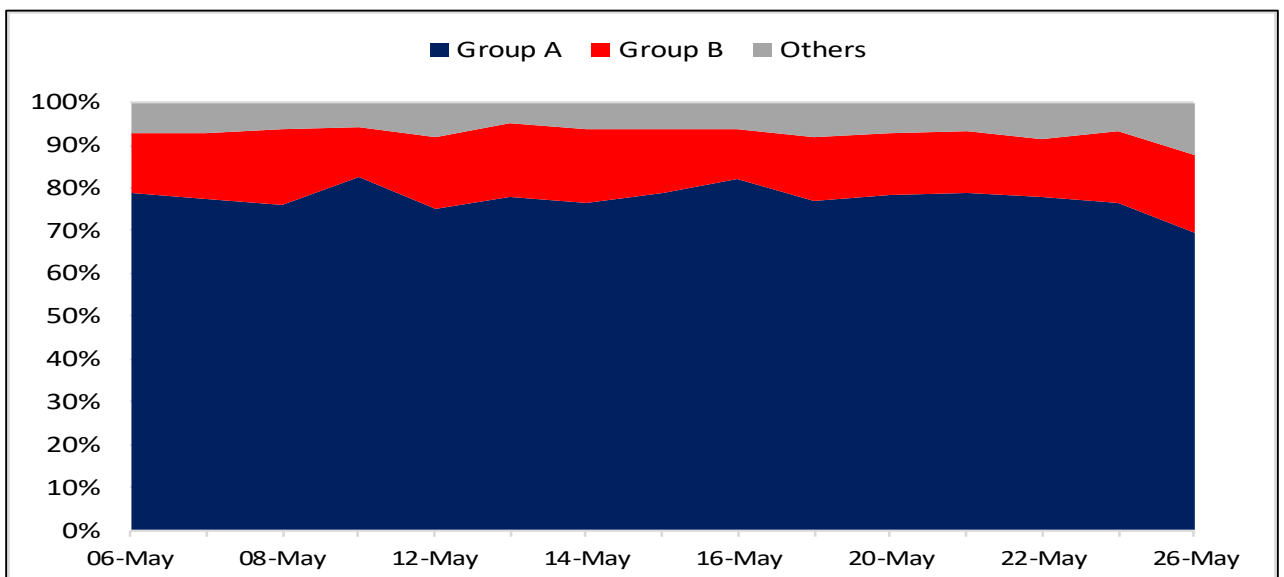

ONGC	ONGC and its partners have resumed production at the PY-3 Field in the Cauvery Basin after a 14-year shutdown. The field, initially operational in 1997, ceased production in 2011. A revised multi-phase development plan was implemented, with Phase I now complete, to revive the field's output. Hardy Exploration & Production operates the block.
Action Construction (ACE)	Consolidated revenue stood at Rs 960.9 crore growing 14.9% YoY from Rs 835.8 crore for Q4FY24. EBITDA was up 26.1% YoY to Rs 164 crore and EBITDA margin stood at 17% in Q4FY25 vs. 15.5% in Q4FY24. Net profit stood at Rs 119 crore in Q4FY25 vs. Rs 98 crore in Q4FY24 (+21.4% YoY).

Key Events

Japan Leading Index Falls Less Than Estimated

Japan's leading index decreased less than initially estimated in March to the lowest level in three months, final data from the Cabinet Office showed on Monday. The leading index, which measures future economic activity, dropped slightly to 108.1 in March from 108.2 in February. In the initial estimate, the score was 107.7. Similarly, the coincident index that measures the current economic situation came in at 115.9, down from 117.3 in the previous month. The latest score was revised down from 116.0.

European Central Bank official sees potential for interest rate cut

Gediminas Simkus, a member of the European Central Bank's Governing Council, has expressed concerns about inflation falling short of the bank's 2% target. The Lithuanian official stated on Monday that there is a growing risk of this happening due to increased trade friction with the United States and a strengthening euro. Simkus pointed out that the current borrowing costs are at the high end of the neutral rate range.

After reprieve, EU still in fix to find trade deal to satisfy Trump

The European Union may have won a reprieve from U.S. President Donald Trump's threatened 50% tariffs, but it remains unclear how the bloc will square its push for a mutually beneficial trade deal with Washington's demands for steep concessions. Trump backed away from imposing the levies on EU imports from June 1 after a call with European Commission President Ursula von der Leyen, restoring a July 9 deadline to allow talks between the U.S. and the 27-nation union to produce a deal.

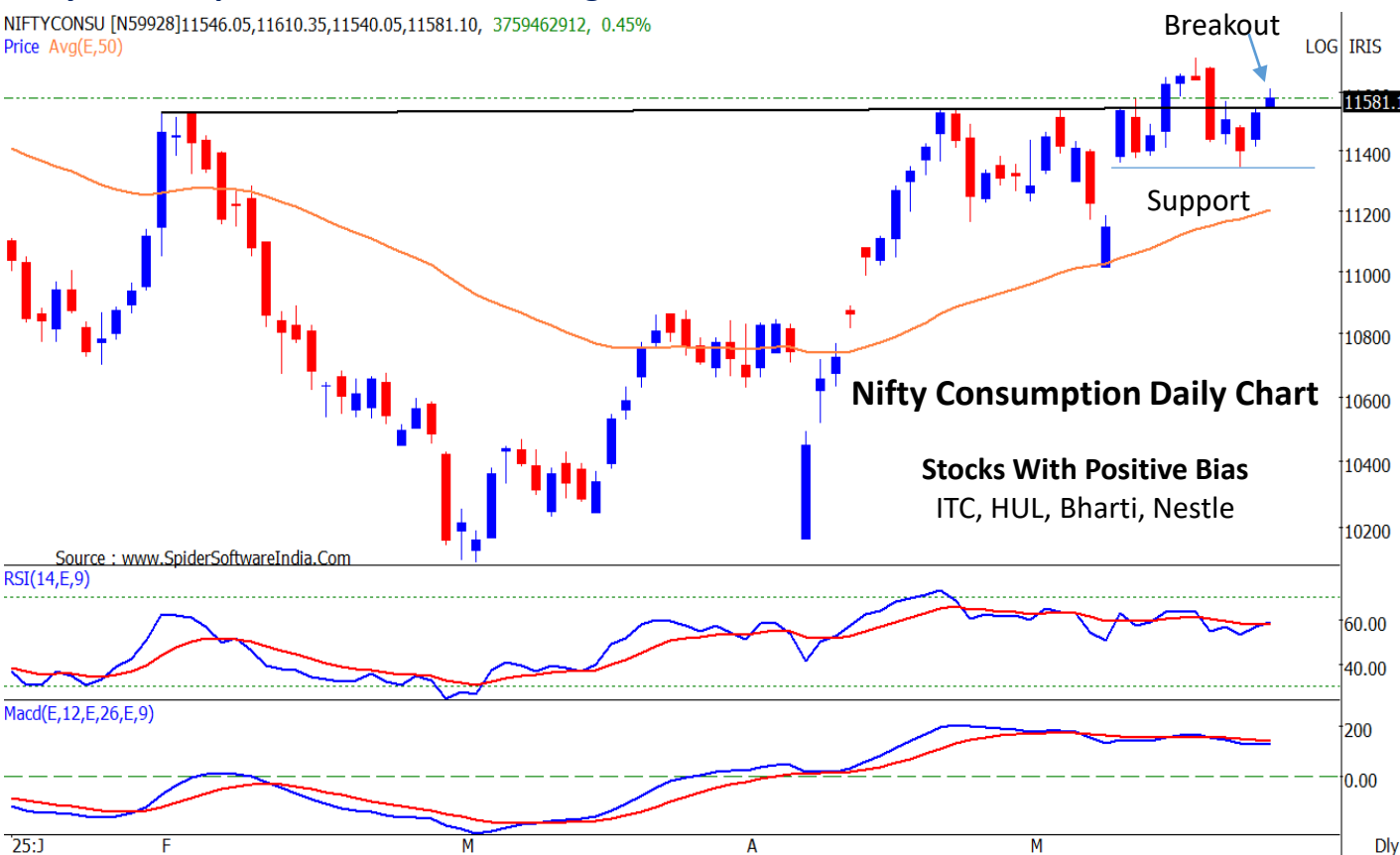
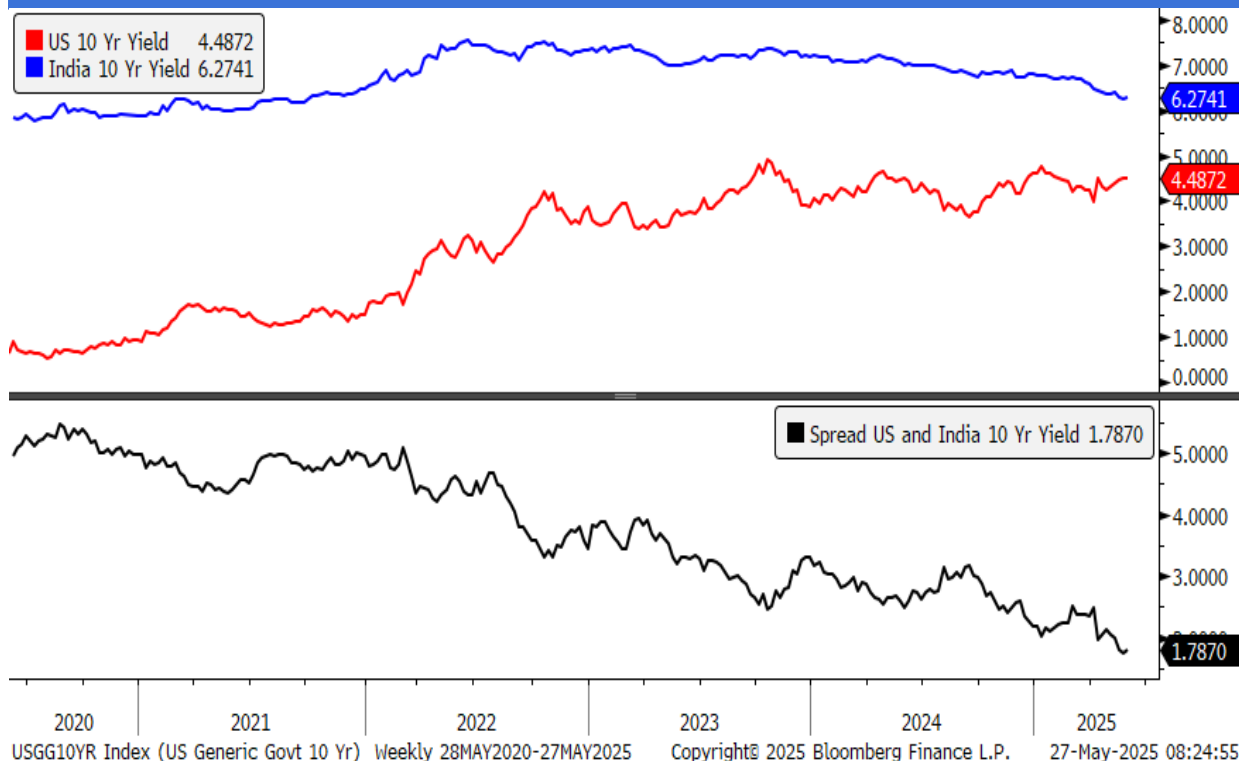

India-US 10 Year Yield Gap at 20-Year Low

- The spread between the benchmark 10-year India debt and the US has shrunk to about 179 basis points, driven by India's strong fiscal position, easing inflation, and expectations of lower interest rates.
- Indian bond yields have been declining, driven by the country's strong fiscal position, easing inflation, and expectations of lower interest rates. This trend diverges from the US, where unfunded tax cuts have sparked fiscal concerns.
- India's bond yield premium over the US has narrowed to its smallest in two decades, likely risking fund outflows from local debt. Foreign funds have poured a net \$2.3 billion in rupee debt this year, though the current quarter has seen about \$4 billion of outflows.

LONG BUILD UP WAS SEEN IN THE NIFTY & BANK NIFTY FUTURES

Create Longs with the SL of 24800 Levels.

- In yesterday session Nifty after Opening 66 points higher at 24,919, the index extended its gains to 25,079 in the early morning session. Post 11 A.M., Nifty entered a narrow consolidation, ultimately closing with a gain of 148 points (0.60%) at 25,001, marking its highest close since May 16, 2025.
- Long Build-Up was seen in the Nifty Futures where Open Interest rose by 1.68% with Nifty rising by 0.60%.
- Long Build-Up was seen in the Bank Nifty Futures where Open Interest rose by 1.70% with Bank Nifty rising by 0.31%.
- Nifty Open Interest Put Call ratio fell to 1.06 levels from 1.09 levels.
- Amongst the Nifty options (29-May Expiry), Call writing is seen at 25100-25200 levels, indicating Nifty is likely to find strong resistance in the vicinity of 25100-25200 levels. On the lower side, an immediate support is placed in the vicinity of 24800-24900 levels where we have seen Put writing.
- Long build-up was seen by FII's in the Index Futures segment where they net bought worth 565 cr with their Open Interest going up by 8817 contracts.

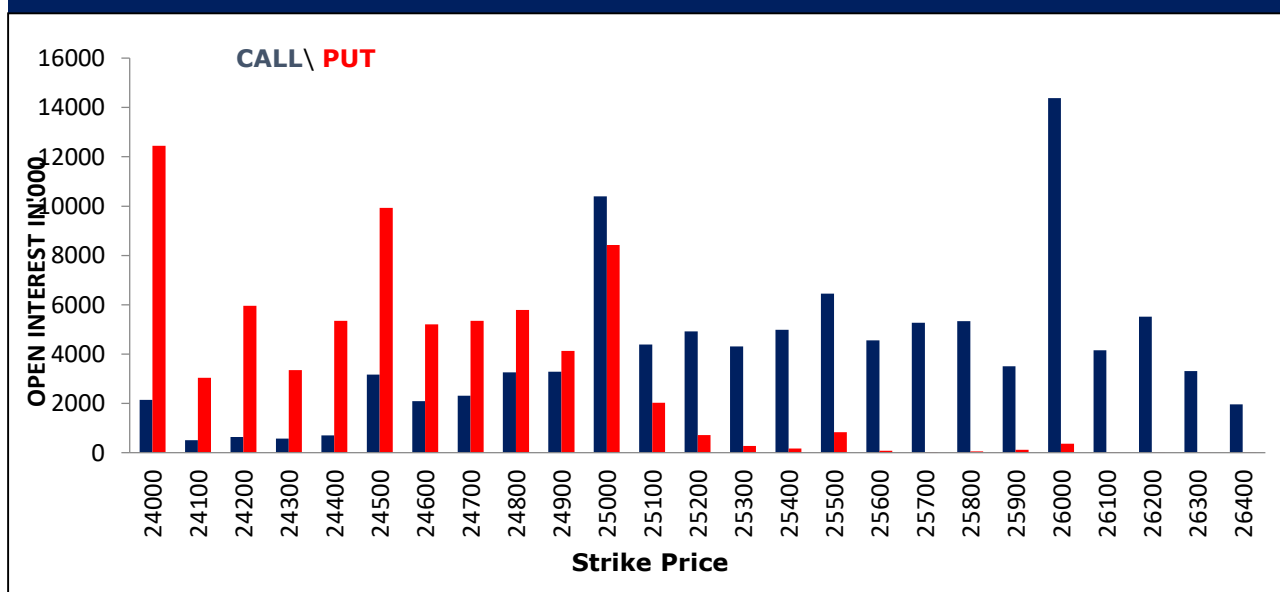
