Tech Retreat Deepens Amid AI Bubble Concerns, Nvidia Results Awaited

Wall Street stocks closed sharply lower on Tuesday as technology shares retreated amid concerns about AI valuations, and bitcoin briefly dipped below \$90,000, signalling reduced risk appetite.

All three major U.S. stock indexes ended deep in negative territory, while crude and gold advanced, and Treasury yields dipped.

Nvidia shares tumbled as traders braced for results that could significantly impact markets, given recent AI bubble fears. Outside tech, Home Depot slipped after missing earnings and cutting its full-year outlook.

European shares hit a one-month low, with German stocks at near five-month lows, as investors grew wary of tech valuations and dimming prospects for a December Fed rate cut.

A strong Nonfarm Payrolls report on Thursday could trigger repricing for further easing next month. According to the CME FedWatch Tool, markets now assign a 50% probability to a December rate cut—up from 46% earlier in the day but below last week's 67%.

Early today, oil prices slipped 0.2% to around \$60, as supply concerns rose and a modest U.S. inventory build has kept oil relatively stable despite broader market selling.

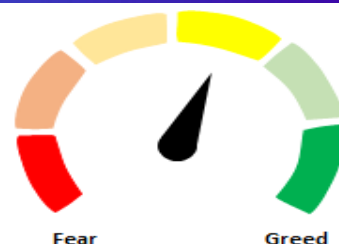
Nifty snapped its six-session winning streak yesterday, slipping 103 points to close at 25,910 as broad-based selling dominated the session.

A breakdown below the low of 25,876 could open the door for further declines toward the next support zone of 25,700–25,750.

On the upside, Nifty needs to reclaim the 26030 high.

Indian markets are likely to open mildly higher on the back of positive Asian cues.

Nvidia's Wednesday earnings report will test whether the AI boom has staying power amid mounting valuation concerns.

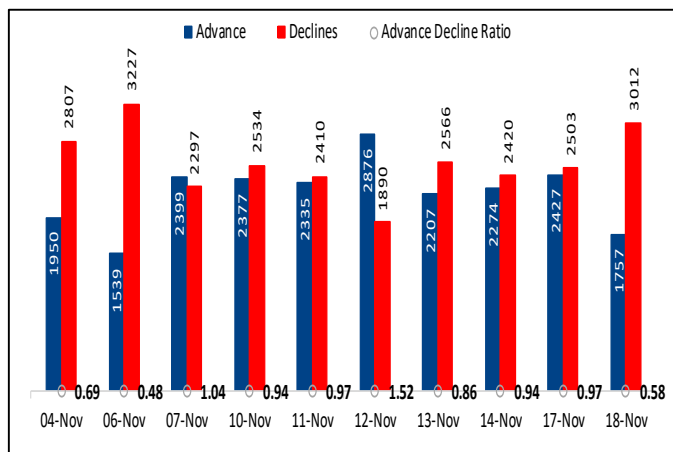

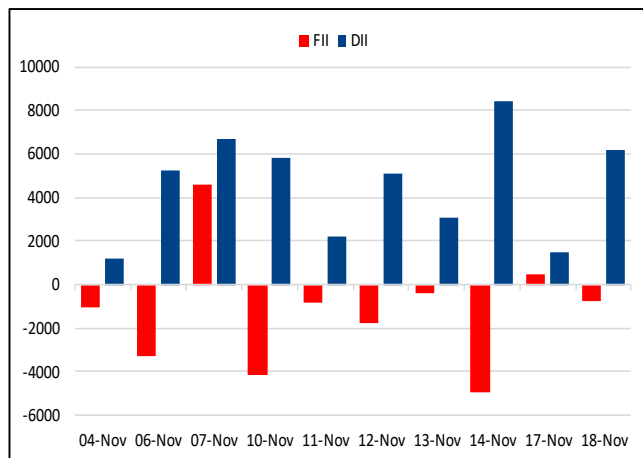

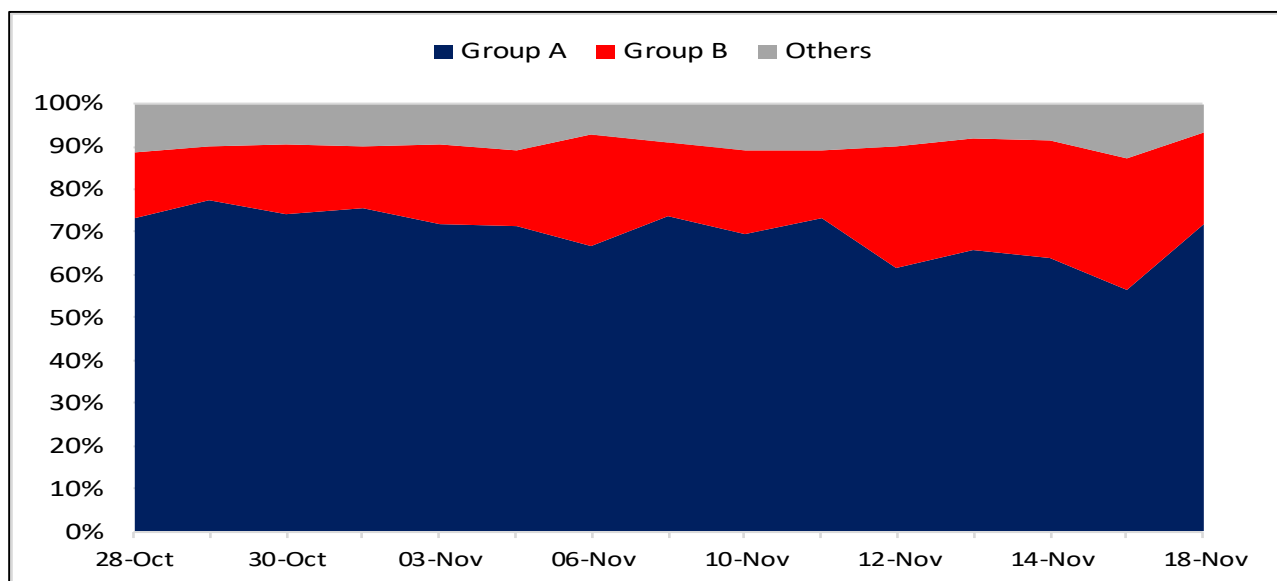

UK pay settlements rise to highest in 2025, Brightmine says

Median pay settlements granted by British employers in the three months to the end of October rose to their highest so far this year at 3.3%, up from 3% in the three months to September. Brightmine said the move reflected higher public sector pay deals which took effect in August and September.

The Bank of England is closely monitoring wage growth for signs of inflation pressure in the economy.

US Factory Orders Rebound, meeting expectations with 1.4% increase

Factory orders, a key indicator of the health of the US manufacturing sector, have seen a significant rebound. The actual increase recorded was 1.4%, precisely in line with forecasted figures.

This 1.4% rise in factory orders marks an important turnaround from the previous period, which saw a decrease of 1.3%. The increase indicates a resurgence in the total value of new purchase orders placed with manufacturers, a positive sign for the US economy and the manufacturing sector in particular.

China's youth unemployment rate edges down to 17.3% in October

China's unemployment rate for young people aged 16 to 24, excluding college students, decreased to 17.3% in October from 17.7% in September, according to data released by the National Bureau of Statistics.

The jobless rate for 25 to 29 year-olds held steady at 7.2% compared to the previous month, the bureau reported.

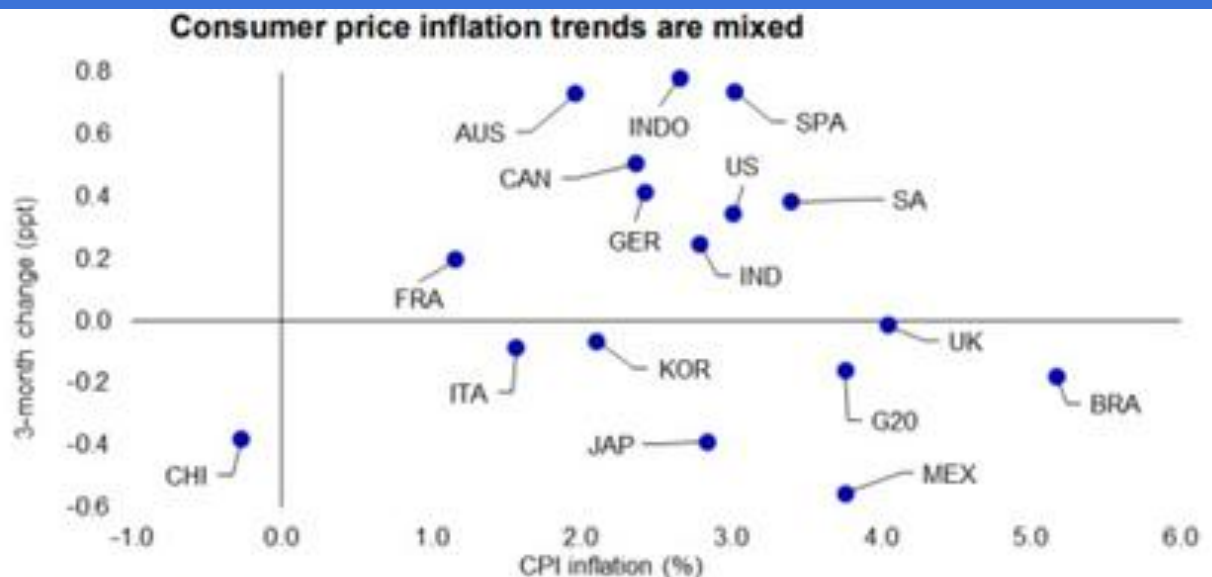
For older workers aged 30 to 59, the unemployment rate showed a slight improvement, dropping to 3.8% in October from 3.9% in September.

Chart with Interesting Observations

Amid Divergent Global Inflation Trends, India Shows Stability

- The scatter plot shows that inflation dynamics across G20 economies remain highly uneven. Brazil and Mexico sit on the far right with the highest CPI inflation readings, while China and Japan are positioned at the low end, with China also showing a clear deflationary trend.
- Several countries—including Australia, Indonesia, and Spain—display strong upward momentum in prices, reflected in their large positive three-month changes. Meanwhile, major economies such as the US, Canada, and Germany show moderate inflation with mild acceleration, whereas the UK, Italy, and the G20 average exhibit signs of cooling.
- India is positioned in the mid-range of the scatter. The country is experiencing stable but mildly falling inflation

LONG BUILD UP WAS SEEN BY FIIS IN THE BANK INDEX FUTURES

Create longs on dips with the SL of 25750 levels.

- Nifty snapped its six-session winning streak, slipping 103 points to close at 25,910 as broad-based selling dominated the session. On this weekly expiry day, volatility stayed elevated, with sellers gaining control in the latter half of trade.
- Long Unwinding was seen in the Nifty Futures where Open Interest fell by 0.86% with Nifty falling by 0.40%.
- Short Build-Up was seen in the Bank Nifty Futures where Open Interest rose by 1.10% with Bank Nifty falling by 0.11%.
- Nifty Open Interest Put Call ratio fell to 1.01 levels from 1.11 levels.
- Amongst the Nifty options (25-Nov Expiry), Call writing is seen at 26000-26100 levels, indicating Nifty is likely to find strong resistance in the vicinity of 26000-26100 levels. On the lower side, an immediate support is placed in the vicinity of 25700-25800 levels where we have seen Put writing.
- Long build-up was seen by FII's in the Index Futures segment where they net bought worth 117 cr with their Open Interest going up by 352 contracts.

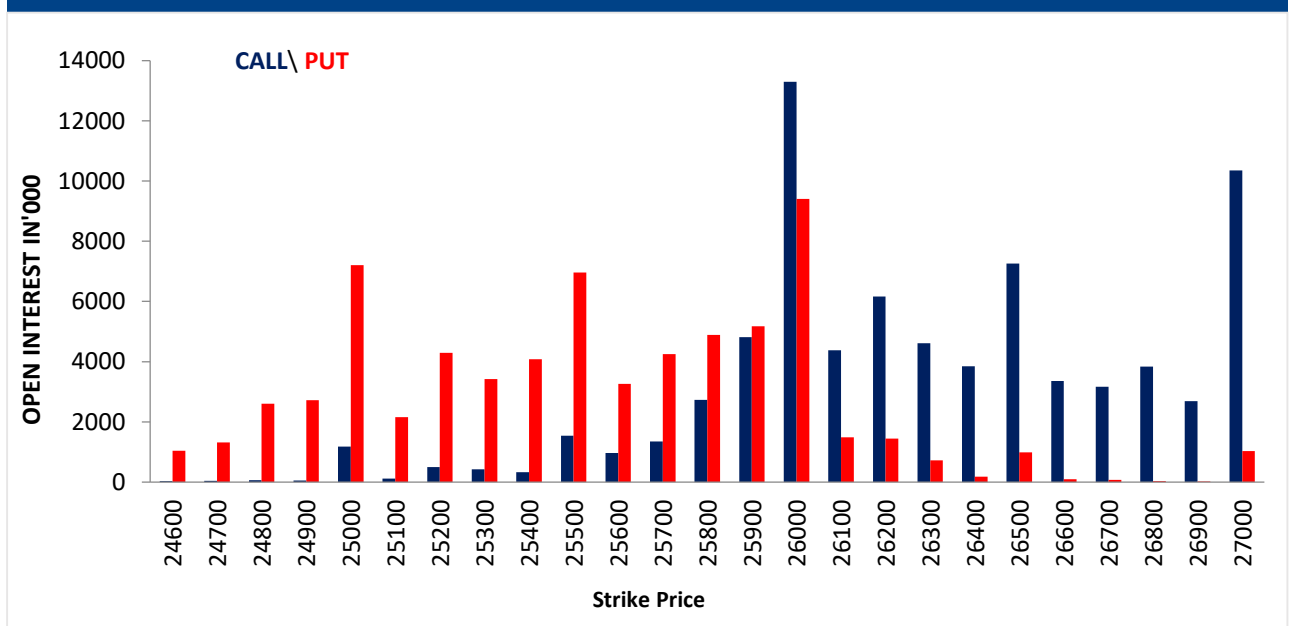
