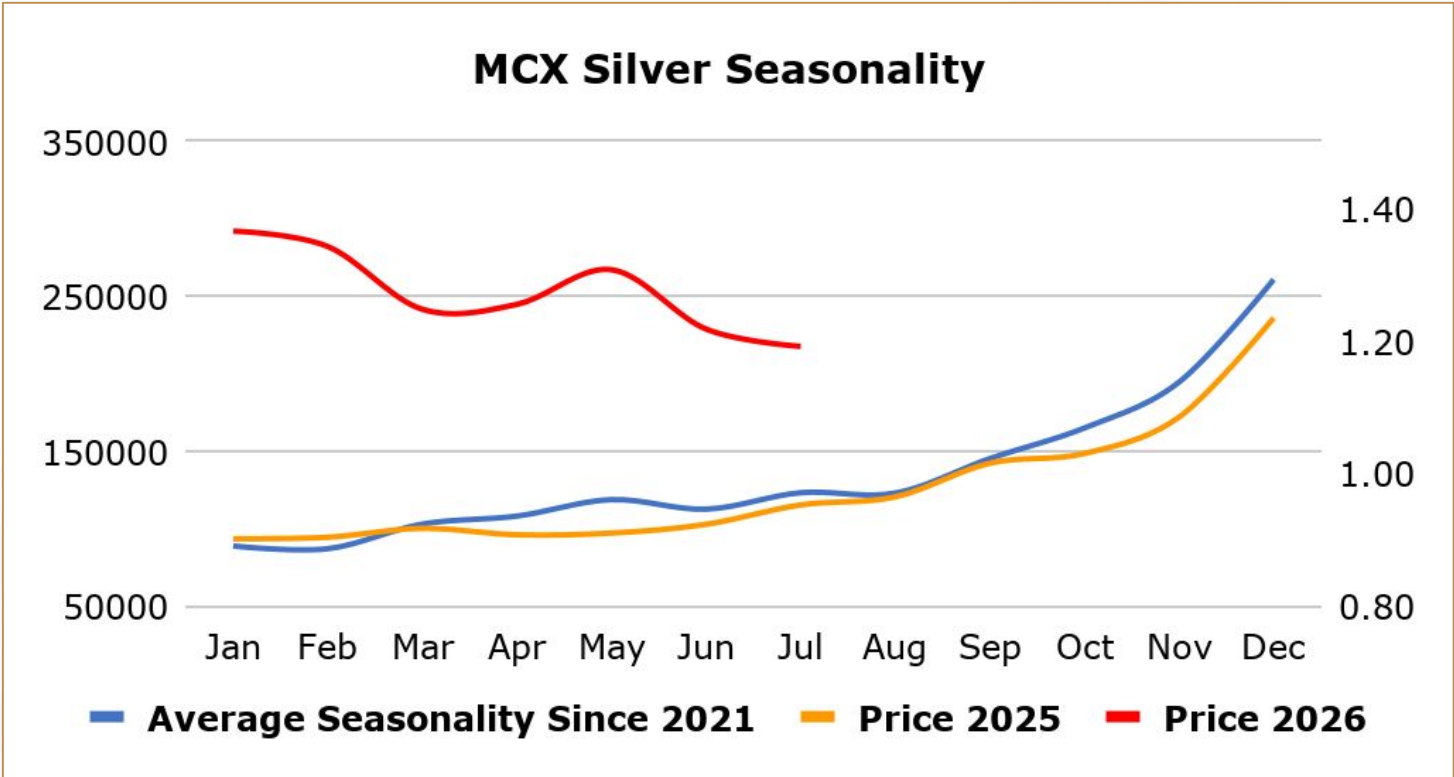
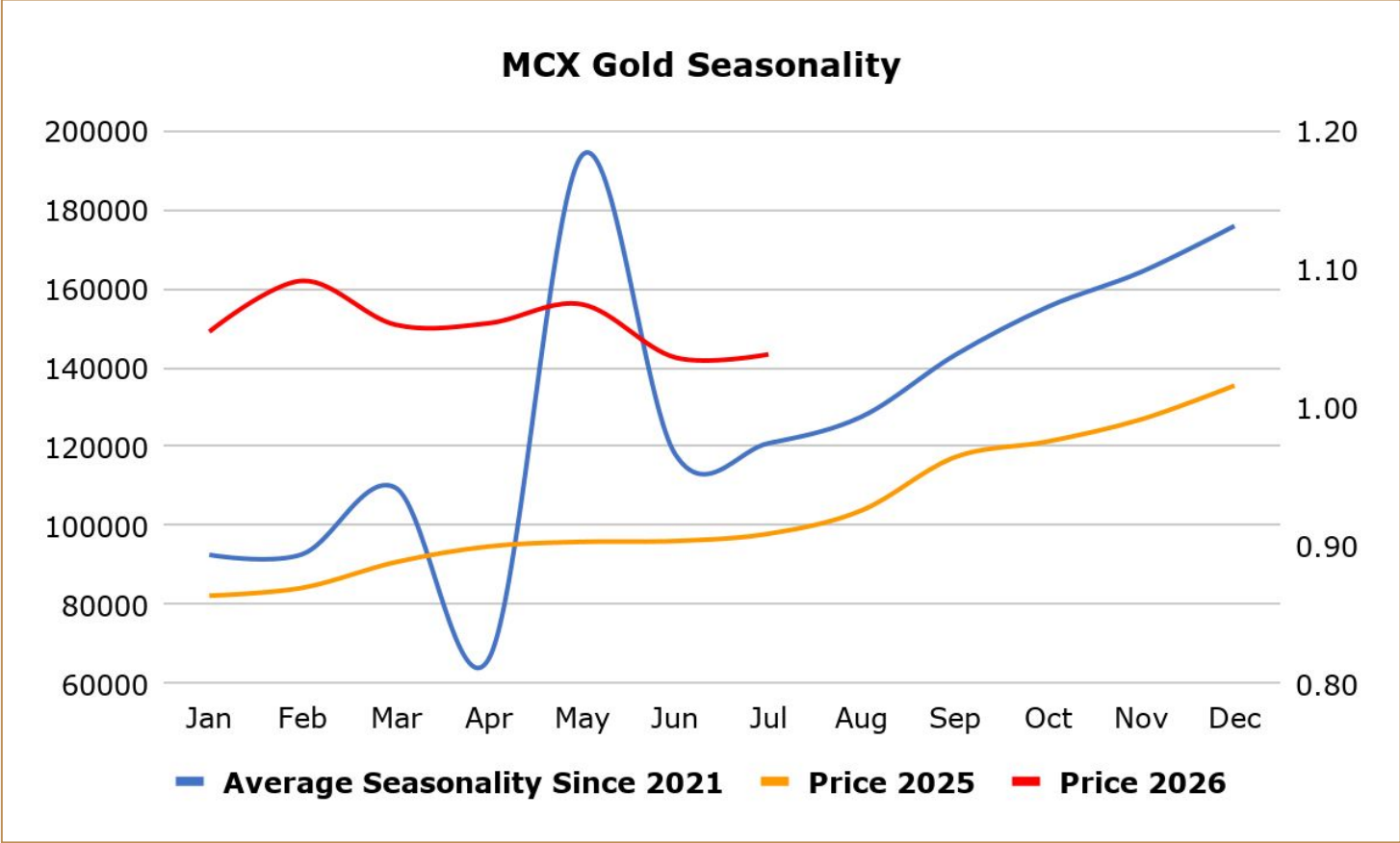
Gold nudged higher as investors weighed mixed signals on potential U.S.-Iran talks and awaited a series of U.S. labour market reports for clues on the Federal Reserve's interest rate trajectory. Reports on U.S. labour market due this week include job opening data later in the day, the ADP employment report on Wednesday and nonfarm payrolls figures on Friday. U.S. President Donald Trump said talks with Iran were under way, warning of a "last chance" for Tehran to sign a good deal, but Iran denied that negotiations were being held or planned. The conflict has driven up energy costs and stoked inflation fears, which could prompt central banks to raise interest rates to keep price pressures in check. Traders currently price in a 65% chance of a rate hike in September after a divided Fed maintained the status quo at its last policy meeting.

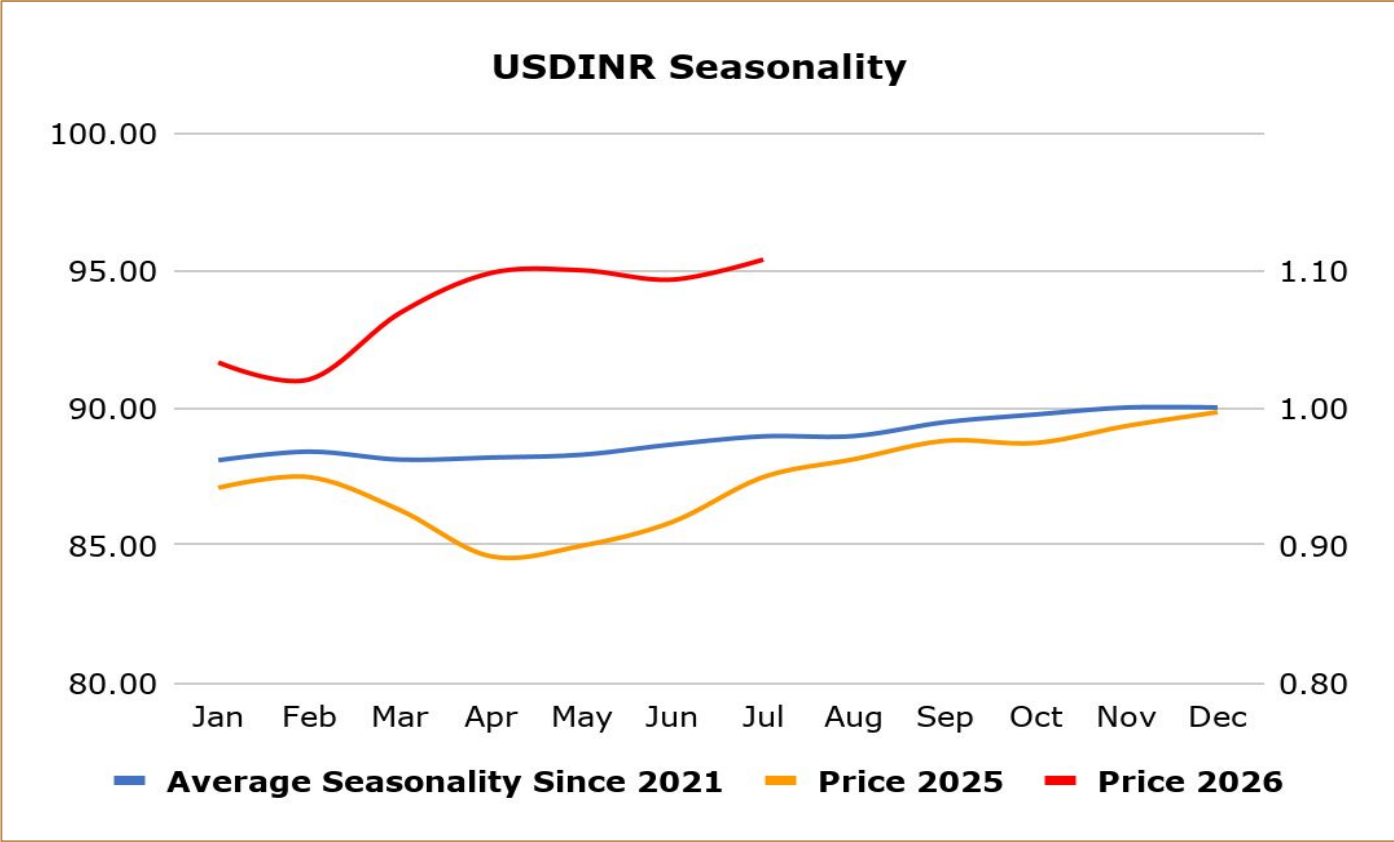
India gold demand muted, stronger yuan boosts buying in China - Gold demand in India stayed muted as buyers waited for clearer price direction, while a stronger yuan lifted purchases in top consumer China. Dealers quoted discounts of up to \$44 an ounce over official domestic prices, compared with last week's discounts of up to \$56. In China, bullion traded at premiums of \$5 to \$8 an ounce over the global benchmark spot price up from last week's premium of \$3 to \$6. In Hong Kong, physical gold traded at a discount of \$0.25 to a \$1.60 premium, while in Japan (XAU-TK-PREM) gold was sold at a discount of \$0.25. In Singapore, gold was sold at a \$0.50 discount to a \$1.70 premium, versus a \$1 discount to a \$2 premium last week.

Gold demand steady in second quarter as central bank buying offsets ETF outflows - Global gold demand was steady year-on-year at 1,268.9 metric tons in the second quarter of 2026 as central banks sped up purchases, offsetting a slump in investment, the World Gold Council said. Outflows from gold-backed exchange-traded funds totalled 45 tons in the second quarter, when bullion posted its sharpest quarterly decline since 2013, falling 14%. Led by Poland and China, central bank net gold demand picked up significantly in the second quarter, reaching 289 tons – a fivefold increase from the first quarter's revised estimate of 57 tons, the WGC said. It estimated January to March demand from central banks at 244 tons three months ago, but then Turkey, Russia and Azerbaijan's Sofaz reported detailed data about their sales for the period.

China's June net gold imports via Hong Kong up from year ago, down from May - China's net gold imports via Hong Kong more than doubled year-on-year in June, but slipped over 5% from the previous month, data from Hong Kong's Census and Statistics Department showed. The world's top gold consumer imported a net 50.679 metric tons of gold via Hong Kong in June, compared with 53.674 tons in May and 19.366 tons in June 2025, the data showed. China's total gold imports via Hong Kong stood at 78.147 tons in June, up 19% from May's 65.562 tons. China's central bank reported its biggest monthly increase in gold reserves in more than 2-1/2 years in June, official data showed. Reserves hit 75.44 million fine troy ounces by the end of June, versus 74.96 million a month earlier.

Swiss gold exports slip 3% in June as shipments to Britain fall - Swiss gold exports fell 3% in June from the previous month as lower shipments to Britain and China offset higher deliveries to India and Saudi Arabia, Swiss customs data showed. Deliveries to the UK from Switzerland, the world's biggest bullion refining and transit hub, fell to 27.4 metric tons last month from 39.4 tons in May. Britain is home to the world's largest over-the-counter gold trading hub. Shipments to China, the world's biggest gold consumer, declined to 27.9 tons in June from 31.6 tons in May. Supplies to India, another key bullion consumer, meanwhile rebounded to 7.4 tons in June from just 955 kg in May, which was the lowest monthly amount in six years after India raised import tariffs for precious metals to support the rupee. Deliveries to Saudi Arabia meanwhile quadrupled in June from the previous month to 10.3 tons.



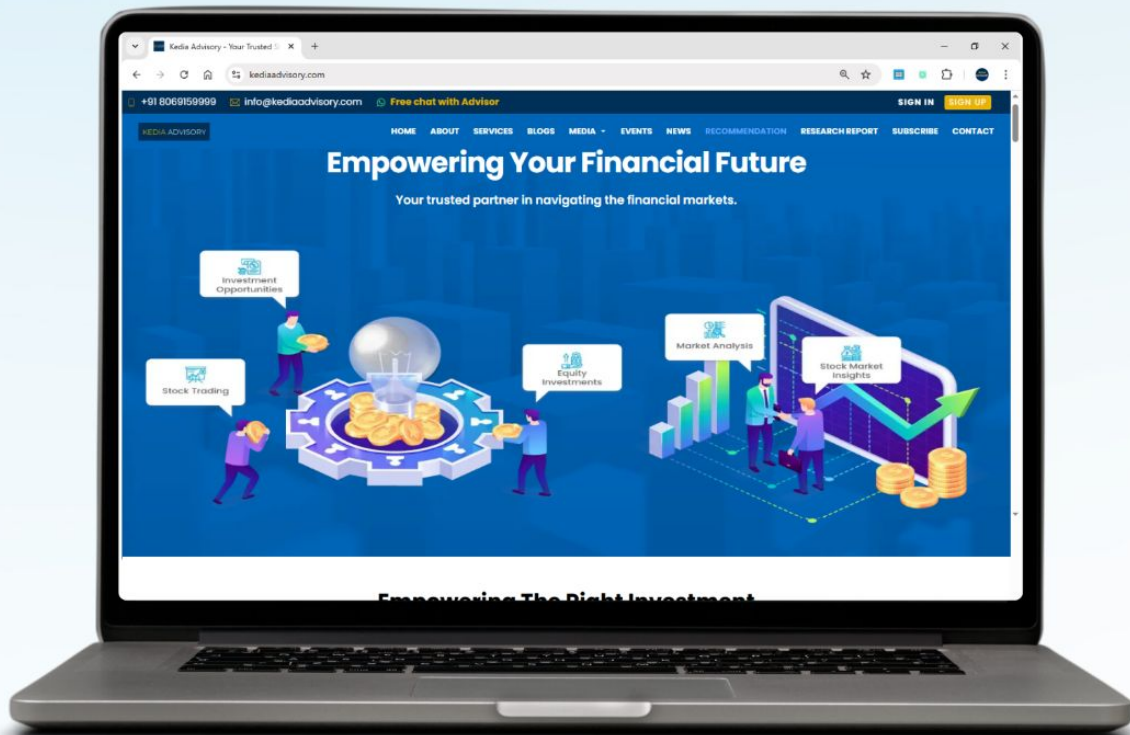
