Geopolitical Turbulence Heightens Investor Anxiety Across Global Markets

Wall Street indexes posted substantial gains on Monday, buoyed by hopes that the Iran-Israel conflict will de-escalate in the near term. The major averages all ended the day firmly in positive territory, with the tech-heavy Nasdaq delivering a standout performance that pushed U.S. benchmarks close to record highs.

The rally offered stability after volatile trading on Friday, when the S&P 500 declined by over 1% and oil prices spiked more than 7% following escalating geopolitical tensions between Israel and Iran. While the human cost of the conflict cannot be dismissed, markets found their footing on Monday amid reports suggesting limited disruption to the global energy supply chain thus far.

However, the Middle East situation remains fluid, and markets retain the potential for sudden volatility should tensions escalate further. This uncertainty was reinforced when U.S. stock index futures declined Tuesday after President Donald Trump issued a stern warning against Iran over the ongoing conflict, while stating that Tehran should have pursued a nuclear deal with the United States.

Looking ahead, household spending and monetary policy will dominate investor attention this week. Retail sales data for May are scheduled to be released on Tuesday, alongside industrial production figures.

Expectations suggest a modest decline in headline retail sales for May, while control-group sales—which exclude more volatile categories such as building materials, petrol stations, and motor vehicles—are projected to rise by 0.2%.

The U.S. Federal Reserve's two-day meeting is scheduled to begin on Tuesday and conclude on Wednesday. The central bank is widely expected to maintain interest rates at their current level when the meeting concludes. Comments from Chair Jerome Powell regarding the future path of interest rates will be closely scrutinised, particularly given recent signs of cooling inflation coupled with continued economic resilience.

Nifty continued its recovery, which started from Friday's low and ended yesterday's session with the gains of 228 points or 0.92% at 24946. By closing above 24,937, the Nifty has successfully retraced more than 61.8% of the entire fall and filled the whole of the downward gap that was formed on Friday, on a closing basis.

Support for the Nifty has now shifted up near 24700. The upside, represented by the swing high of 25222, could offer near-term resistance in the Nifty.

U.S. President Trump's latest comments on Iran kept investors on edge regarding the geopolitical outlook. Indian markets are poised to open mildly lower on the back of weak Asian cues and lower U.S. futures.

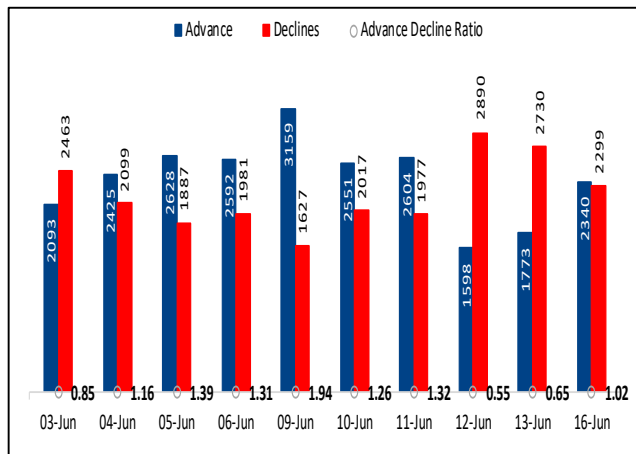

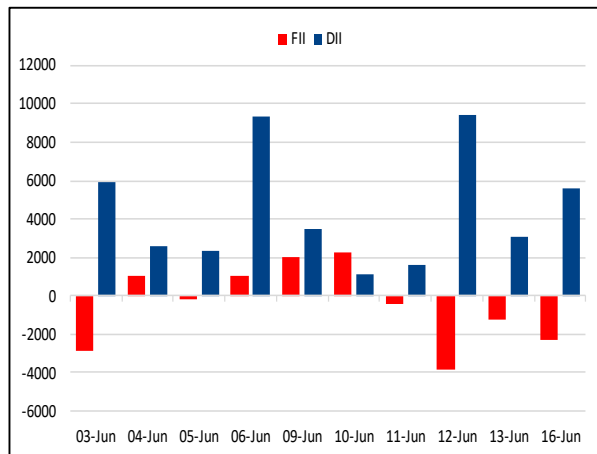

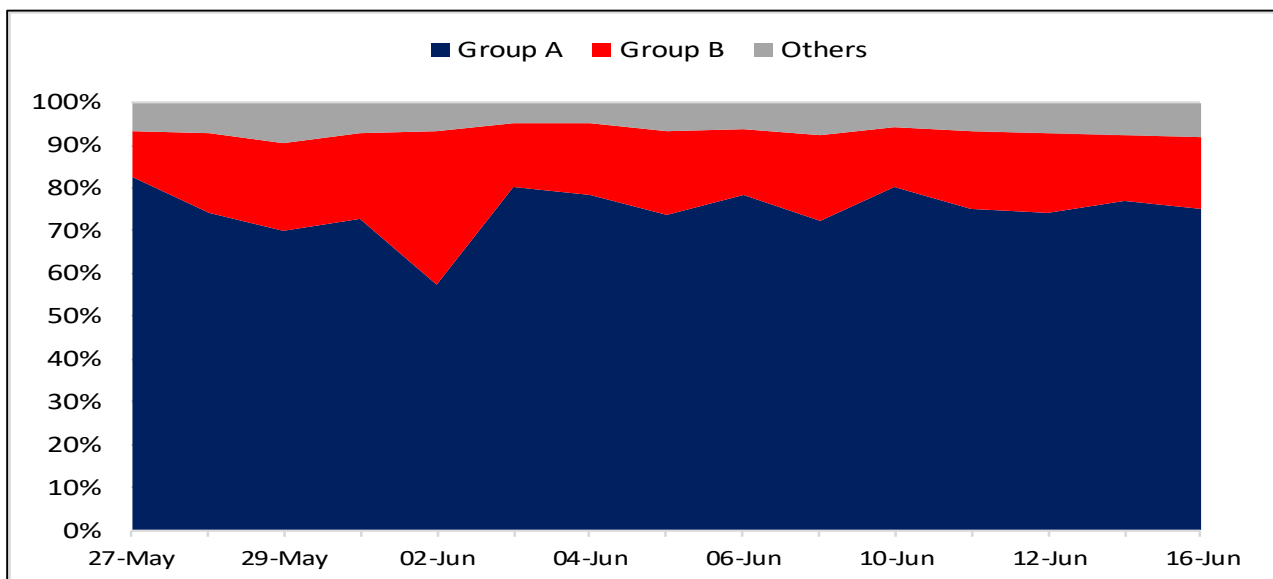

EU dismisses reports that it is ready to accept flat 10% U.S. tariff

The European Commission dismissed on Monday reports suggesting it was willing to accept a broad U.S. tariff of 10% on EU goods as speculative and said they did not reflect current discussions. "Negotiations are ongoing, and no agreement has been reached at this stage. The EU has from the start objected to unjustified and illegal U.S. tariffs," the Commission said in a statement.

China industrial production misses expectations in May; retail sales surge

Chinese industrial production grew slightly less than expected in May as high U.S. trade tariffs dented overseas orders and weighed on domestic output. But other data showed Chinese retail sales blew past expectations in May on support from holiday spending and local shopping events, which helped offset broader weakness in consumer spending. Industrial production grew 5.8% year-on-year in May, government data showed on Monday. The reading was just below expectations of 5.9% and fell from the 6.1% rise seen in the prior month.

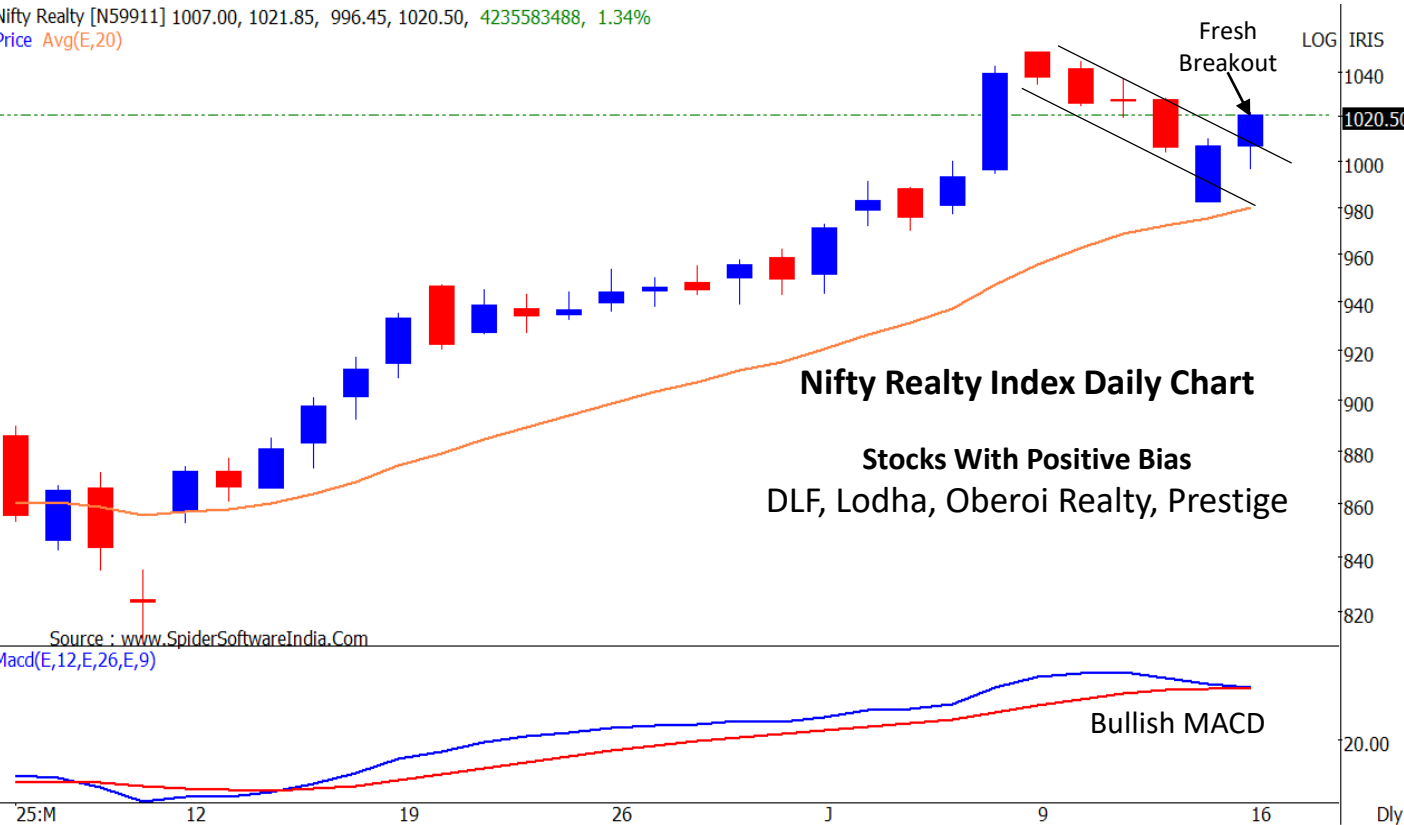


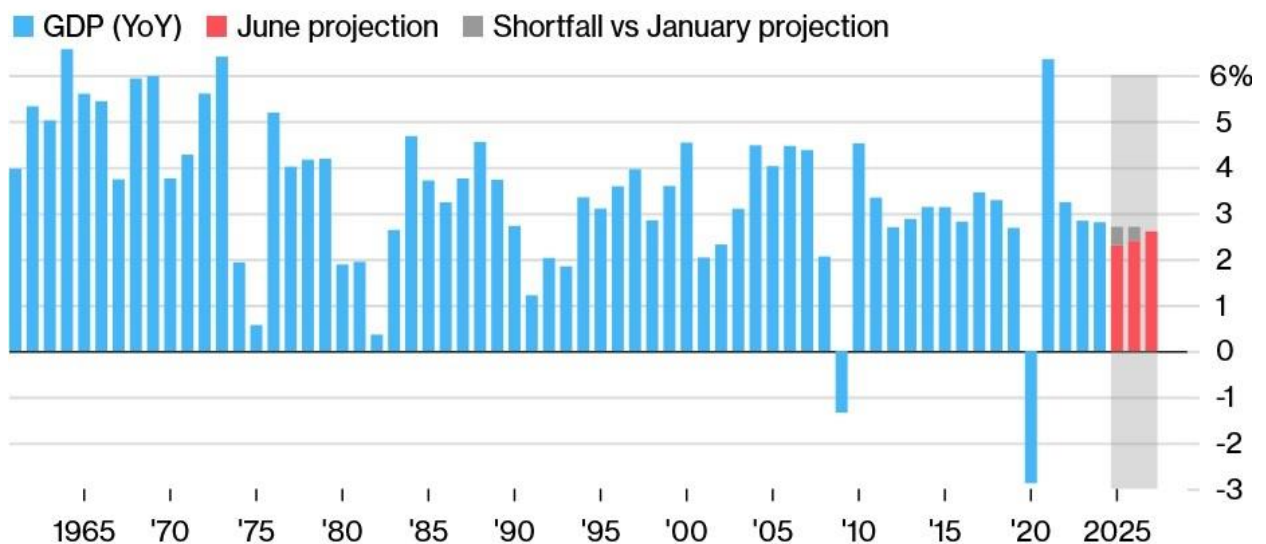

Decade of Doldrums: Global Growth at 60-Year Nadir

- The latest World Bank's Global Growth forecasts highlight the profound impact of recent upheaval, projecting a nearly half-percentage-point reduction in the global GDP growth rate. The revised figure for 2025 could be 2.3%, marking the weakest performance in 17 years, a decline not seen outside of global recessions.
- *By 2027, the average global GDP growth rate for the 2020s is anticipated to be 2.5%, a deceleration unprecedented since the 1960s.*
- Growth in developing economies has steadily declined over the past three decades, falling from an average of 5.9% in the 2000s to 5.1% in the 2010s, and further to 3.7% in the 2020s. This mirrors the trajectory of global trade growth, which similarly decreased from an average of 5.1% in the 2000s to 4.6% in the 2010s and to 2.6% in the 2020s.

LONG BUILD UP WAS SEEN IN NIFTY FUTURES

Create Longs with the SL of 24850 Levels.

- Nifty continued its recovery, which started from Friday's low and ended the day with the gains of 228 points or 0.92% at 24946.
- Long Build-Up was seen in the Nifty Futures where Open Interest rose by 1.12% with Nifty rising by 0.92%.
- Short Covering was seen in the Bank Nifty Futures where Open Interest fell by 2.01% with Bank Nifty rising by 0.75%.
- Nifty Open Interest Put Call ratio rose to 1.14 levels from 0.89 levels.
- Amongst the Nifty options (19-Jun Expiry), Call writing is seen at 25000-25100 levels, indicating Nifty is likely to find strong resistance in the vicinity of 25000-25100 levels. On the lower side, an immediate support is placed in the vicinity of 24900-24800 levels where we have seen Put writing.
- Long build-up was seen by FI's in the Index Futures segment where they net bought worth 420 cr with their Open Interest going up by 2332 contracts.

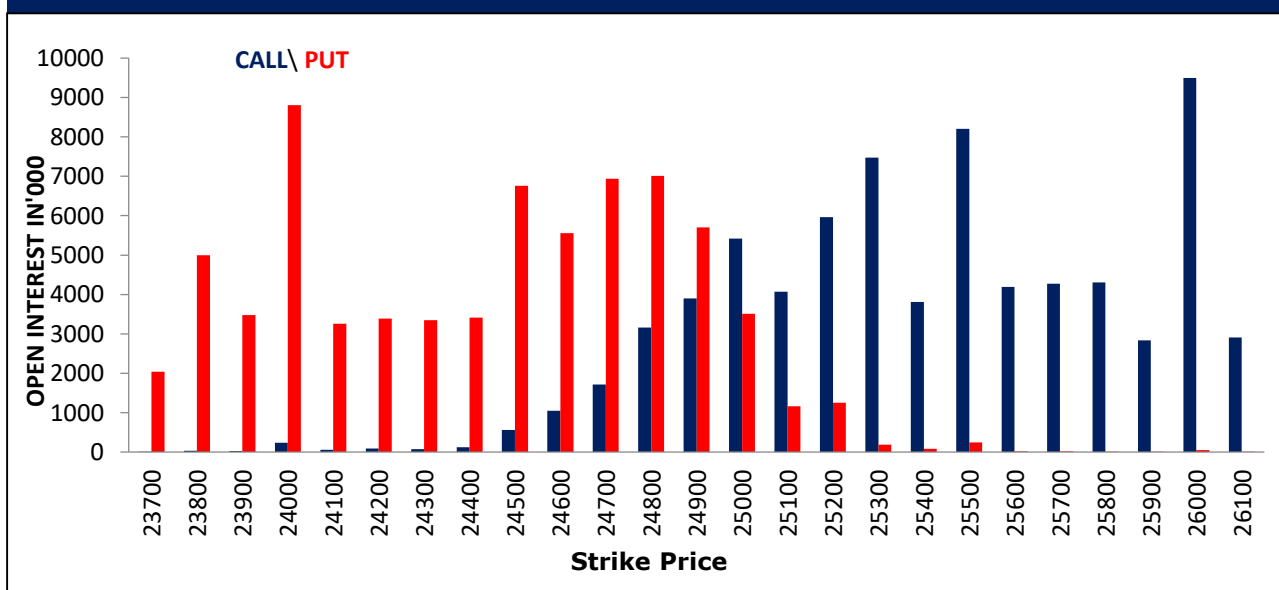
